



Telamon Corporation — DELAWARE

ECMHSP first provided funding to Telamon Corporation in Delaware in 1988 for services to sixty children and their families. The program was fortunate to locate space in the Kent County Vocational/Technical School which already had an operational day care center for teaching students interested in child care. Migrant children were served from late June to mid-August, providing Head Start activities to fifty-six children.

In 1991, Telamon Corporation was awarded a grant from Region III for the provision of a regular Head Start program in Kent County. Immediately, plans were formulated to acquire a new permanent center. Until completion, Head Start for all children was conducted in a small, dilapidated establishment that needed copious renovation to maintain license. This situation changed in 1992 when the new facility was assembled. It consists of five classrooms, a great room for indoor play and meeting space, and a large outside play area.
