## INTRODUCTION

ECMHSP is a federally funded, non-profit Corporation that is headquartered in Raleigh, North Carolina. ECMHSP provides high quality and comprehensive Head Start services in rural areas of Alabama, Florida, Georgia, Indiana, North Carolina, Oklahoma, South Carolina, and Virginia and maintains an administrative office in Washington, DC. What makes ECMHSP truly special is our ability to meet the unique needs of farmworker families, who often live in hard-to-reach rural areas and work long days for extremely low wages. ECMHSP provides a full array of Head Start services to migrant and seasonal farmworker families. With more than 40 years of providing high-quality services exclusively to farmworker families, ECMHSP is recognized nationally as a model for excellence and well trusted in the community.

ECMHSP provides direct Head Start services at eleven Migrant Head Start Campuses located in Florida, three Early Head Start Campuses located in Florida, eight Migrant Head Start Campuses located in North Carolina, three Migrant Head Start Campuses located in Alabama, three Migrant Head Start Campuses in South Carolina, and two Migrant Head Start Campuses in Virginia. ECMHSP also subcontracts to two non-profit delegate agencies that provide Head Start services on the east coast of the United States. ECMHSP receives approximately \$64,000,000 from the Department of Health and Services under CFDA 93.600 for the operation of the Migrant and Seasonal Head Start Program. ECMHSP also receives U.S. Department of Agricultural funding which passes through each state to operate the Child and Adult Care Food Program (CACFP).

### 1.0 PURPOSE

The purpose of this Request for Proposal (hereinafter “RFP”) is to provide Food Service Vendors and other interested parties (hereinafter “Food Service Vendors”) with information to enable them to prepare and submit a proposal to meet the specifications and requirements for East Coast Migrant Head Start Project’s (hereinafter “East Coast”) Child Nutrition Program in Florida. The contract will begin on or about September 25, 2023, and terminate on or about September 30, 2026. A firm-fixed price contract will be awarded. Any contract(s) that may be issued also includes provisions for East Coast Migrant Head Start Project at its sole discretion, to renew the contract(s) for up to two (2) additional one (1) year term, encompassing fiscal years ending 2023/24, 2024/25 and 2025/26.

### 2.0 NOTICE TO RESPONDENTS

Cost Proposals for furnishing food service to meet the needs of East Coast’s Child Nutrition Program must be received at East Coast’s Raleigh Regional Office by no later than 5:00 p.m. on Friday, September 8, 2023. It is the responsibility of the party submitting a Cost Proposal in response to this RFP to ensure that the Cost Proposal is received by the deadline.

East Coast Migrant Head Start Project shall not be obligated to answer any questions received after the above-specified deadline or any questions submitted in a manner other than as instructed above. #### **4.0 Who May Respond**

Cost Proposal responsive to the RFP will be accepted from all qualified Food Service Vendors who are able to meet the required RFP specifications and selection criteria.

#### **5.0 Contract Award Process**

An award may be made on the basis of the cost proposals initially submitted, without discussion, clarification, or modification; or on the basis of negotiation with any of the Food Service Vendors. For purposes of negotiation, a competitive range of potentially acceptable proposals may be established by East Coast. After the submission of a proposal and before making an award, East Coast may permit a Food Service Vendor to revise the proposal in order to obtain the best and final offer. East Coast reserves the right to award a Contract for all or any portion of the requirements proposed by this request, reject any and all proposals if deemed to be in the best interest of East Coast, or re-solicit proposals.

#### **6.0 Criteria for Selection**

The Food Service Vendor selected for an award will be the vendor whose proposal is the most advantageous to East Coast. East Coast is not bound to accept the lowest priced proposal if that proposal is not in the best interest of East Coast as determined solely by East Coast. East Coast personnel will evaluate proposals based upon the following criteria:

- Food Service Vendors experience providing the requested goods for other similar organizations.
- The overall cost to ECMHSP for the goods provided.
- The quality of references from past customers of Food Service Vendor.
- Food Service Vendor's demonstrated capability to provide goods in the time projected.
- Food Service Vendor's responses to the Questionnaire.
- Integrity of the Food Service Vendor and compliance with public policy.

#### **7.0 Cost of Preparing Cost Proposal**

All costs incurred in the creation of a Cost Proposal will be the responsibility of the Food Service Vendor and will not be reimbursed by East Coast.

In general, Head Start campuses operated by ECMHSP serve children on a seasonal basis throughout the program year. For example, campuses directly operated in Florida by ECMHSP, the growing and harvesting season begins in the late fall and continues through the late spring or early summer of the following year. Accordingly, in Florida, ECMHSP opens Head Start campuses for migrant farm worker families beginning in the latter part of October and closes those Head Start campuses in late May or early June. The only exceptions are the Dundee and Okeechobee1 locations which operate year-round. Beginning in the late spring, migrant families travel upstream to engage in agricultural labor. Based upon the needs of the families, ECMHSP will open campuses beginning in the spring and continuing into the early summer and close these campuses when migrant farm workers leave the service area of the Head Start campus. In addition, enrollment in a particular Head Start Campus may vary significantly during the program season. Accordingly, food service orders by East Coast may vary significantly from week-to-week based upon child enrollment level.

**9.0 Products to be supplied**

The successful Food Service Vendor is to supply Food and Non-food products pursuant to the attached specifications.

**10.0 Non-collusion Representation**

By signing below, the Food Service Vendor represents and warrants that the quotation has been made without contacting any other Food Service Vendor and is in all respects fair and made without collusion or fraud.

**11.0 Applicable Documents and Information to be Submitted by Food Service Vendor**

**11.01 Product Lines:**

The Food Service Vendor will provide information concerning national and regional food brands stocked with grade identification. All foods must be of high quality and conform to all federal requirements including all USDA and FDA requirements. The Food Service Vendor is required to document brand name (if any) and the specific grade, pack, or description of the product.

**11.02 Pricing:**

The Food Service Vendor will indicate the prices for representative product.

**11.03 Pricing Structures:**

The Food Service Vendor will define pricing structures, requirements for maintaining pricing efficiencies, discounts on delivery efficiencies, and all remaining stipulations that may impact pricing strategies.

**11.04 Payments:**

The Food Service Vendor will indicate payment schedules, early pay discounts, finance charges, and procedures for pickup or credit. Please note whether a Purchase Order is acceptable.

**11.05 Ordering:**

The Food Service Vendor will define procedures and options for ordering food, lead-time requirements, fill rate percentage, methods for notification of order completion or shortages, and methods for handling back orders or substitutions.

**11.06 Interruption of Services**

The Food Service Vendor must furnish written evidence of arrangements with another vendor in the event that the Food Service Vendor is unable to perform its obligations for any reason.

**11.07 Insurance**

The Food Service Vendor must maintain the following types of insurance in the following amounts:

Products Liability	\$1 million primary
Umbrella Liability	\$5 million

Insurance companies licensed to do business in the State of Florida must issue policies. The Food Service Vendor must provide a certificate of insurance evidencing the scope of insurance coverage.

- 11.08 Transportation:** The Food Service Vendor will define food transport modalities, including average shelf life or turnaround time of dairy, fresh meat, and produce perishables.
- 11.09 Food Delivery:** The Food Service Vendor will identify the frequency of deliveries and delivery documentation. Preferably, deliveries will be received twice weekly. The Food Service Vendor must be able to deliver during the working hours of food service staff. Food items must be clearly labeled on the exterior and arrive in an acceptable condition. East Coast reserves the right to refuse any products that do not meet our standards upon delivery.
- 11.10 Support Services:** The Food Service Vendor will furnish information concerning the cost and provision of computer-assistance programs, food rebate programs, education services, and other specialty services, if available.
- 11.11 Hazardous Communication Regulations:** Identification by the Food Service Vendor of products containing any toxic substances, toxic material, or infectious agents is required. Material Safety Data Sheets for the products must accompany the quotation.
- 11.12 References:** The name, contact person, and telephone number must be provided for two other agencies serviced by the Food Service Vendor (the agencies preferably will be Head Start, preschool or day care programs).

## **12.0 Standard Terms and Conditions of Food Service Contract**

- Definitions:
  - “Contract” shall mean the Request for Proposal, the Execution of Offer, and Food Service Vendors Questionnaire.
  - “Food Service Vendor” shall mean the individual, partnership, corporation, or other entity responding to this Request for Proposal.
  - “Contractor” shall mean the individual, partnership, corporation, or other entity awarded a Contract pursuant to this Request for Proposal.
- 12.01 Entire Agreement.** The Contract is intended as the complete and exclusive statement of the agreement between East Coast and the Contractor and shall supersede all prior or contemporaneous agreements, negotiations or oral representations relating to the subject matter herein.
- 12.02 Time of Performance:** Time is of the essence in the rendering of services hereunder. Contractor agrees to perform all obligations and tender services set forth in this Request for Proposal in accordance with the schedules herein and as mutually agreed upon between East Coast and Contractor during the term of this Contract.

- 12.03 Termination for Cause:** In the event that the Contractor fails to carry out or comply with any of the terms and conditions of the Contract, East Coast may notify the Contractor of such default or failure in writing and demand that the failure or default be remedied within ten days. In the event that the Contractor fails to remedy such failure or default within the ten-day period, East Coast shall have the right to hold Contractor in breach of the Contract and to recover whatever damages it may be entitled to at law or in equity.
- 12.04 Termination for Convenience:** The Contract may be terminated without penalty by East Coast for convenience by giving thirty (30) days written notice of such termination to the Contractor. In no event shall termination by East Coast as provided for in this paragraph give rise to any liability on the part of East Coast including, but not limited to, any claims of Contractor for compensation for anticipated profits, unabsorbed overhead, or interest on borrowing. East Coast's sole obligation hereunder is to pay Contractor for services provided prior to the date of termination.
- 12.05 Independent Status of Parties:** Contractor will neither hold itself out as nor claim to be an officer, partner, employee, or agent of East Coast by reason hereof, and that it will not by reason hereof make any claim, demand, or application to or for any right, or privilege applicable to an officer, partner, employee or agent of East Coast.
- 12.06 Contract Amendments:** The Contract may be amended by mutual written consent of the parties. No modifications or amendments to the contract shall become valid unless in writing and signed by both parties.
- 12.07 Compliance with Law:** East Coast is a federally funded, non-profit corporation. Individuals and corporations desiring to do business with East Coast must certify that they have not been debarred from receiving federal funds. By submitting a response to this Request for Proposal, Food Service Vendor is certifying that it and its principals:
- Are not presently debarred, suspended, proposed for debarment, declared ineligible, or voluntarily excluded from covered transactions by any Federal department or agency;
  - Have not within a three-year period preceding this transaction been convicted of or had a civil judgment rendered against them for commission of fraud or a criminal offense in connection with obtaining, attempting to obtain, or performing a public (Federal, State or local) transaction or contract under a public transaction; violation of Federal or State antitrust statutes or commission of embezzlement, theft, forgery, bribery, falsification or destruction of records, making false statements, or receiving stolen property;
  - Are not presently indicted for or otherwise criminally or civilly charged by a government entity (Federal, State, or local), with commission of any of the offenses enumerated in this certification; and
  - Have not within a three-year period preceding this application/proposal had one or more public transactions (Federal, State or local) terminated for cause or default.
- 12.08 Access to Documents:** To the extent applicable to this procurement, Contractor agrees to grant access by East Coast, the Administration for Children & Families, the United States Department of Agriculture, and the Comptroller General of the United States or

any of their duly authorized representatives to any books, documents, papers, and records of the Contractor, which are directly pertinent to this Contract, for the purpose of making audit, examination, excerpts, and transcriptions.

- 12.09 Acceptance of Services:** All services furnished under this Contract shall be to the satisfaction of East Coast and in accordance with the scope of work, specifications, terms, and conditions of the Contract.
- 12.10 Indemnification:** Contractor agrees to indemnify, protect and hold harmless East Coast and its officers, directors, and employees from and against all claims, damages, losses, causes of action, suits or judgments arising out of, caused by, or resulting from, the provision of goods by Contractor pursuant to this Contract, which are caused in whole or in part by any negligent act or omission of the Contractor.
- 12.11 Force Majeure:** If either East Coast or Contractor is delayed at any time in the performance of its obligations hereunder by economic industry-wide strikes, fire, unusual delay in deliveries, unavoidable casualties, or other causes reasonably beyond such party's control and which could not have been reasonably anticipated by that party, then the time for performance of such party shall be extended by one day for each day of such delay.
- 12.12 Non-Disclosure:** Contractor and East Coast acknowledge that they or their employees may, in the performance of the resultant Contract, come into the possession of proprietary or confidential information owned by or in the possession of the other. Neither party shall use any such information for its own benefit or make such information available to any third person, firm, corporation, or other organization.
- 13.0 Governing Law:** This Contract shall be construed and governed by the laws of the state of Florida.
- 14.0 Right to Reject**
- East Coast reserves the right to reject any or all proposals received in response to this RFP.
- 15.0 Notification of Award**
- East Coast anticipates selecting the successful proposal within two weeks of the closing date for receipt of proposals. Upon conclusion of final regulations with the successful Food Service Vendor, all Food Service Vendors submitting proposals in response to the RFP will be informed, in writing, of the successful bidder.
- 16.0 PROPOSAL EVALUATION AND CONTRACT AWARD**
- An Evaluation Panel consisting of East Coast Migrant Head Start Project personnel will review, analyze and evaluate all proposals received. The Evaluation Panel will qualify and rank the field of Potential Food Service Commodities RFP Contractors. East Coast Migrant Head Start Project may require the finalists to make an oral presentation to the Evaluation Panel to further explain their proposals. If such interviews are conducted, appraisals of the presentations will also be factored into the final scores assigned by the Potential Contractors. However, Potential Contractors are advised that the award may be made without interviews or further discussion. The evaluation panel will take contract recommendations to appropriate East Coast Migrant Head Start Project Committees for approval.



### **16.1 EVALUATION CRITERIA**

By use of numerical and narrative scoring techniques, proposals will be evaluated by East Coast Migrant Head Start Project against the factors specified below. The relative weights of the criteria--based on a 100-point scale--are shown in parentheses. Within each evaluation criterion listed, the sub-criteria to be considered are those described in the "Proposal Format and Content" section of this RFP.

- Cost and price (30)
- Product Breadth & Scope (20)
- Service (15)
- Qualifications, experience, and references of Potential Contractor (25)
- Miscellaneous [exceptions/deviations, completeness of proposal, adherence to RFP instructions, other relevant factors not considered elsewhere] (10)

East Coast Migrant Head Start Project reserves the right to reject any or all proposals, to waive any irregularities or informalities in the offers received and to change the evaluation process described above if circumstances dictate this or it is otherwise in the best interest of East Coast Migrant Head Start Project to do so. In the event a proposal(s) is rejected, or in the event a Potential Contractor's offer is not rejected but does not result in a contract award, East Coast Migrant Head Start Project shall not be liable for any costs incurred by the Potential Contractor in connection with the preparation and submittal of the proposal.

Suspension and Debarment

ECMHSP is funded under a grant from the United States Department of Health and Human Services, Administration for Children & Families, Office of Head Start. Individuals and corporations desiring to do business with ECMHSP must certify that they have not been debarred from receiving federal funds. By entering into Agreement, Contractor is certifying that it and its principals:

- (1) Are not presently debarred, suspended, proposed for debarment, declared ineligible, or voluntarily excluded from covered transactions by any Federal department or agency;
  - (2) Have not within a three-year period preceding this transaction been convicted of or had a civil judgment rendered against them for commission of fraud or a criminal offense in connection with obtaining, attempting to obtain, or performing a public (Federal, State or local) transaction or contract under a public transaction; violation of Federal or State antitrust statutes or commission of embezzlement, theft, forgery, bribery, falsification or destruction of records, making false statements, or receiving stolen property;

- (c) Termination for Cause: This agreement may be terminated for material breach in accordance with the terms and conditions of this Agreement.
- (d) Clean Air Act and Federal Water Pollution Control. Contractor agrees to comply with all requirements of the Clean Air Act and the Federal Water Pollution Act and all regulations and guidelines listed thereunder. Contractor shall promptly notify the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services and the regional office of the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency upon any violation of the Acts or their regulations and guidelines.
- (e) Energy Efficiency: Contractor will comply with mandatory standards and policies relating to energy efficiency which are contained in the North Carolina energy conservation plan issued in compliance with the Energy Policy and Conservation Act (42 U.S.C. 6201).
- (f) Record Access: Contractor agrees to make available any books, documents, papers, and records which are directly pertinent to this Agreement for the purpose of making audits, examinations, excerpts, and transcription to the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services, the U.S. Comptroller General, or any other their duly authorized representatives.
